

## **Industria Dance Centre's COVID-19 Procedures**

**Considering the health and safety of our dancers, please ensure you are screening yourself, your child(ren) and those you've been in close contact with before attending a class at Industria Dance Centre.**

**DO NOT come to class if in the last 14 days you have been in contact with someone that is a suspect or is confirmed to have COVID-19.**

**DO NOT come to class if you have returned from international travel within the last 14 days.**

**DO NOT come to class if you have a new onset of any of the following symptoms: fever/chills, cough, loss of taste/smell, sore throat/hoarse voice, shortness of breath, vomiting or diarrhea for more than 24 hours.**

**DO NOT come to class if you have a new onset of two or more of the following symptoms: runny nose, muscle aches, fatigue, conjunctivitis, headache, nausea or loss of appetite, skin rash of unknown origin.**

### **ENTERING THE STUDIO**

- Only two classes will be allowed into the building at a time, this means that our classes will end 10 minutes early to allow for those dancers to leave and the next set of dancers to enter the building
- As per the guidelines of the Manitoba government there will be a maximum occupancy of 50 people in the building at a time. On average, Industria will have approximately 25 people occupying the building at a time.
- You have the option of lining up outside the building moving east towards Oxford Learning and the nail salon, or you may wait in your vehicles (preferred method) prior to the start of class.
- After the previous classes have exited the building, an Industria staff member will then open the door and allow one person into the building at a time. Children 6 and older will enter the building by themselves and children 5 and under are allowed one parent into the building with them. This parent will then leave and return ten minutes prior to the end of class to pick up their child. If you are late and there is no staff member at the door, please enter the building and ring the doorbell to alert a staff member that is in the office.
- You must sanitize your hands when entering and exiting the building and hand sanitizer will be available in multiple areas throughout the building.
- When dancers enter the building they will take their shoes off at the door, pick them up and walk right to the studio door, where their teacher/assistant will greet them. They will put their belongings down on a socially distanced marked spot along the wall and find their spot in the room. We have taped off 6 foot squares in both studio's to ensure we maintain an appropriate distance from each other as much as we can while we dance.
- Please come with your dance clothes on underneath, as the change room will be closed. Teachers and assistants can help the younger children with their clothes and shoes once they enter the studio. NOTE: When helping children prepare for class, teachers and assistants will sanitize their hands between children.

## EXITING THE STUDIO

- When class is over, students will exit the studio one at a time. We ask that parents who are able to park right against the building, stand in front of their car to ensure your child can find you when we escort them out. Parents who park in the middle of the lot can come and stand against the studio's windows remaining 6 feet apart from others.
- REMINDER that classes will end 10 minutes early to allow time to exit the building. This will also help minimize the amount of contacts families have when attending Industria.
- NOTE: Classes for the 2020/21 dance season are already scheduled 5-10 minutes apart so classes will end as dictated.

## OTHER THINGS TO CONSIDER

- Wearing masks is optional, but recommended if children feel comfortable wearing them while they dance
- Payments for tuition will only be taken by credit card through your account on Studio Director or by E-Transfer to [info@industriadancecentre.com](mailto:info@industriadancecentre.com). If these options aren't possible for you, please contact Miss Jill at [jillian@industriadancecentre.com](mailto:jillian@industriadancecentre.com) to arrange an alternative method of payment.
- For the younger classes, where props are involved, we will only be using props that we can properly clean between classes.
- Only one bathroom will be available to dancers and will be disinfected daily and in between classes by the staff. We also encourage you to have your children use the bathroom at home prior to coming to dance class.
- Surfaces will be cleaned/disinfected between each class (barre's, door handles, etc.)
- If you have a break between classes, we ask that you go home and return later for your next class.
